Endnotes

1. The first 8 ranked projects include unscored projects (HMIS and CE) as well as two projects who have only just begun receiving their CoC award and have not served enough households for performance evaluation (Ain Dah Yung Center Supportive Housing 2017 and Prior Crossing 2017).
2. CE and HMIS projects are not scored the funding awarded to these projects is obligatory as declared by Heading Home Ramsey's FY 2015, FY 2016, and FY 2017 CoC Competition Priorities. All new projects are listed within this field and did not receive scores.
3. Target population, for those projects which target multiple populations, does not demonstrate the distribution of beds and units by population served. For instance, a larger project serving singles and families may have an unequal balance of units dedicated to these two populations.
4. Because the ROOF Project Wilder Renewal FY19 project straddles Tier 1 and Tier 2, it is separated into two projects within this priority listing. The total award for this project is \$856,738.
5. The Safe Journeys Transitional Housing and Rapid Rehousing project has \$200,613 of its grant above the annual renewal demand. All following ranked projects' funding requests are above the annual renewal demand/
